ROCK YOUR LIFE! Mentoring

Dear parents,

ROCK YOU LIFE's purpose is accompanying secondary school graduates during their transition into professional life or to further education considering their individual interests and talents. University level students act as their mentors and are trained specifically for the task of working with them on a one to one basis to develop their strengths and work towards realizing their professional goals. Mentors support the teenage graduates with decisions regarding their further educational path and with preparing the entrance into professional life (job search and selection / job applications). To that end ROCK YOUR LIFE offers free training to teenage graduates consisting of a three-day seminar which they attend together with their mentors and in which they learn about recruitment, career paths and establishing a personal career plan and milestones. Our aim is to support the development the personality, individual talents and social competence of teenage graduates and to enable them to conduct a self-dependent life.

We appreciate the trust you put in us and thank you for enrolling your child in our program. We don't take this trust for granted – at ROCK YOUR LIFE! we work in transparent and open ways and build on mutual responsibility. Please sign the attached document which serves as your official approval that your child can participate in ROCK YOUR LIFE!'s program.

Please find a summary of the components below:

0. Agreement to participate in ROCK YOUR LIFE!'s program

In this part we ask you to provide all relevant information about your child as well as your contact information, which is required to conduct the program. You may also provide us with additional, non-mandatory information about your country of origin which will be used for internal purposes only.

1. Who we are. What we do.

ROCK YOUR LIFE! - an overview:

In this part we present the detailed contents of the RYL! program. These are the key points:

- Mentors (University level students) are specifically trained by ROCK YOUR LIFE! and are required to present an extract from police records before starting their work.
 Mentors work in an honorary capacity and are not paid.
- The focus of the mentoring activity is on accompanying and supporting your child in preparing the entrance into professional life (job search and selection / job applications).
- In addition, your child may visit a three-day seminar with his/her mentor to learn about finding personal strengths and career paths.
- One to one personal discussions are at the core of the mentoring activity between the mentor and your child.



- Location, duration and the frequency of one to one discussions are agreed on between the mentor and your child. ROCK YOUR LIFE! suggests one session every 1-2 weeks.
- Repetition of school materials and help on homework is not part of the RYL! Program

2. Agreement to participate in ROCK YOUR LIFE!'s program

In this part, you give your consent that your child will take part in ROCK YOUR LIFE!'s program and you confirm you have understood the above mentioned points.

3. Agreement on usage of personal data

In this part you decide whether we have the right to record audio- and video materials of your child and whether we can use these for non-commercial purposes. We also inform you about your right of withdrawal.

4. Data protection

In this section we inform you about how we use your personal data. We cover the following questions:

- 1. What type of personal data do we collect and use?
- 2. To what purpose do we use your personal data?
- 3. Who do we share your personal data with?
- 4. How safe is your personal data?
- 5. Where is your personal data stored?
- 6. What is your right of withdrawal?

We will only collect and use personal data that is necessary for carrying out the ROCK YOUR LIFE! program. Should you make use of your right of withdrawal the participation of your child in our program cannot continued.

5. Consent

Through your signature you express your consent with articles 1-5 above. We look forward to accompanying your child on his/her journey towards professional life.
